During Danielle's whole group instruction students had questions about how creative they could be with their butterfly and she made adjustments to her lesson after listening to their questions. She was very observant to the students that needed help squeezing the glue bottle harder and covering all of their pencil lines. Danielle gave extra instructional cues to the students that needed a reminder how to use the art materials during the process they were doing for the first time.
